
Installation coming soon!

Thank you to everyone who spoke to us about the plans we published last October. We've spoken to everyone who contacted us with suggestions, which has enabled to change and improve the layout and siting for everyone using and living by the park.

All being well, we expect the equipment to be installed during week commencing 21 January 2019. Not only will there be climbing frames and a slide, but a new fence will enclose the play area. Whilst councillors and volunteers were preparing the layout, they discovered a concrete slab partly hidden under the grass. We're hoping to make best use of that by adding a new bench to sit on the slab, and the waste bin that is currently in the middle of the play area will be relocated by the lower gate.

Once the work has been completed and has been certified as safe to use, it will be open and available for use. However, councillors would like to see a proper open day when everyone in the parish can come down and see what changes have been made, and perhaps give us some ideas for other facilities we can offer. At the moment, the council is looking at a time during the school holidays – perhaps at Easter – when we can have an official opening and maybe a family fun day.
