Jubilee Park Newsletter





Parish Councillors have agreed to set aside £10,000 as part of a plan to **improve children's play equipment** in Jubilee Park. Thanks to a group of local residents who had done the groundwork, councillors were given several options for a mixture of equipment to choose from. The final decision was made at the last public meeting held on October 9, and a small working group has been set up to oversee the delivery and installation.

The **equipment consists of 12 items** that will be located adjacent to the existing swings. We expect to take delivery of the equipment in December and for the groundworks and site preparation to begin soon after.

All being well, the new equipment should be ready for use in **early Spring 2019**. Volunteers from the parish are also planning to repaint the existing swings as part of the park refurbishment.



Throughout December, the parish council **is consulting with all residents** about how they use Jubilee Park at the moment and what else they might like to see there. Look out for the Christmas copy of The Informer where we'll include a short paper survey for you to complete. If you haven't received your copy by 10 December (or would prefer to take the survey online), contact the parish clerk who can send you a copy or the weblink. The survey will only take 2 minutes to complete (drop your completed copy into the Village Hall mailbox) and will help councillors decide what other facilities can be offered.
